

602.1 The Student Government Association formally establishes the Monsignor Robert Sheeran Pirate of the Year Award to formally recognize the accomplishments and service of three university community members yearly.

(a) The three university community members must be made up of one student, one faculty member and one staff member OR administrator.

(b) The nominees and winners of the Pirate of the Year Award, must be able to meet the following requirements:

- i. For student nominees and winner:
  - a. must be in good academic standing
  - b. Cannot be on judicial probation at time of nomination
  - c. Cannot be a current member of SGA
  - d. Must demonstrate exceptional service to the betterment of the Seton Hall community.
- ii. For faculty and administrator/staff nominees and winners:
  - a. Must demonstrate exceptional service to the betterment of the Seton Hall community.
  - b. Must have worked at Seton Hall University – main campus, for a minimum of one year.

602.2 Nominations will be taken by anyone in the university community for students, faculty, staff and administration that exemplify and embody the mission of the university in their study and their work.

(a) Only nomination forms that are filled out completely by the announced deadline will be considered for the Pirate of the Year Award.

602.3 The SGA President shall appoint a chairperson to lead the selection committee, which shall convene to set the dates of the application timeline.

602.4 \$500 shall be allocated during the budget allocation process to the Pirate of the Year Award.

(a) If additional funding is needed, the committee must request funding through the SGA Finance Committee. A member of the Pirate of the Year committee must be present at the Finance Committee meeting to request funding.

602.5 The committee shall consist of four committee members including the SGA Advisor, two members from the ranks of SGA, and one non-SGA member.

(a) The four committee members are full-voting committee members.

(b) The chairperson will only vote in the event of a tie.

602.6 Three winners shall be selected and presented to the President of the University for approval before granting the award.

602.7 Each winner will receive a plaque honoring their award. This plaque will be paid for according to section 602.4.
