UNIVERSITY LIFE PROGRAMMING FOR FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS

What's required for all first-year students?

Each first-year student must attend one of the programs offered by The Career Center during the month of November 2007 (please see calendar for all program offerings). For a description of alumni/program speakers, go to <http://studentaffairs.shu.edu/career/AlumniPresenters.htm>.

How will my University Life professor know that I've attended a program?

Students will use their valid SHU ID to "swipe in" at the start of each program. A Career Center professional will be on hand to assist with the process. This information will then be sent to all University Life professors...so all you need to do is remember to bring your valid SHU I.D. and swipe in!

How long do I have to stay at each program?

Seating will be limited to the first 100 students with a valid SHU I.D., so it's important to arrive early to claim your spot. Doors will close 10 minutes after the program has begun, and students must stay until the end of the program in order for it to count for University Life credit.

What if I cannot attend any of the program dates/times listed?

Although we strongly encourage all first-year students to attend at least one of the programs offered, we understand that this may not be possible for everyone. You can also obtain University Life credit by participating in one of the following:

1. Schedule at least one appointment at The Career Center with a Career Professional prior to Tuesday, November 20th.
2. Participate in a small group discussion on FOCUS on one of the following dates:
 - Mon, Nov 5 - 2-3pm
 - Wed, Nov 14 - 11am-12pm
 - Wed, Nov 28 - 1-2pm

Seating is limited to 6 students on a first come-first served basis. Please plan ahead and stop by our office in Bayley Hall (2nd Floor) or call us at (973) 761-9355 to hold a seat for you!

How can I enter the Essay Contest... and what can I win?

The Career Center is sponsoring an essay contest for National Career Development Month that ties together the theme of "My Career, My Community, My Calling." To enter, submit a 500-word essay answering the question:

How does your personal experience of calling and community impact your career choice?

Two winners will be chosen for a prize of \$100 each, and two will be chosen to receive \$50 each. Prize money will be added directly to the winners' Pirate Gold accounts. Please note: submitting an essay does not fulfill the University Life requirement.
